About the course

This program will provide people with the skills, knowledge and confidence to be able to help ill or injured persons in emergency first aid situations, without placing themselves or others at unnecessary risk.

Who should enrol

The unit applies to all workers who may be required to provide a first aid response in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings

Learning outcomes

Individuals will learn basic life support, CPR & AED, wound care, shock management, airway management and a variety of other important first aid treatments

Attendance, study load and student support

You will be required to:

- Participate in self-paced online e-learning of approximately 7 hours*
- Attend a scheduled face to face classroom delivery (including simulated activities), this includes 6.5 hours per class.
- Please bring a towel to kneel on for this course

*must be completed prior to attending face to face practical day

Assessment

Assessment will include a range of activities such as written tasks, oral questions and observation within a simulated environment.

Entry requirements

Wesley Vocational Institute has set the following entry requirements for enrolment in this course:

- Satisfactory level of language, literacy and numeracy.
- Students are to perform a minimum of 2 minutes of uninterrupted CPR on a manikin placed on the floor. This is a mandatory requirement and there are no exceptions that can be made
- Ability to commit to attendance and study load requirements for this course.
- Be an Australian or New Zealand citizen or Australian Permanent Resident.
